



My  have had a secondary insurance policy with AARP since 4-1-97. The cost of those two plans together was about \$300 monthly. At this time, we were living in 

In April 1999 we moved to  and our monthly charge increased to \$346.50 monthly.

In Sept 2009 we moved to NY and our costs increased to \$465 monthly which is an increase of 35%.

In December 2009 I was advised that the 2010 cost would again increase to \$478.59

In August 2011 another increase is in the works for 2012 which will now cost us \$514 monthly. (\$6,168 annually)

We feel these increases are excessive and we ask that you deny their approval.
