Individual Medicare Supplemental Plans

CDPHP Universal Benefits,[®] Inc. (CDPHP UBI) offers coverage for Standard Individual Medicare Supplemental Plans A, B, F, and N.

These plans are offered throughout the Albany, Mid-Hudson, Syracuse, and Utica regions in New York State.

CDPHP UBI has filed with the NYS Department of Financial Services a request for approval for changes to premium rates for Plans A, B, F, and N in all of its existing regions.

CDPHP UBI is proposing changes to its current rates to cover increased medical costs and correct for past years' pricing. In past years, CDPHP UBI has developed premium rates using New York State Medicare sample data because credible plan experience data was not available due to the newness of the product. Now that CDPHP UBI has some plan experience data to rely upon, the proposed premium rates were developed through a blending of such plan experience data and the New York State Medicare sample data. The proposed rate increase is required as part of CDPHP UBI's effort to ensure the long term ability of this product to be sustainable.

The rate adjustments proposed in this filing will be effective on January 1, 2015. There are currently 4,707 Individual Medicare Supplemental policyholders encompassing all regions. The rate adjustments will affect the proposed premiums depending on the policyholder's plan type and region.

A summary of the proposed percentage change for each plan, by region, is presented in the table below.
